



Creating Aspirations and Putting Youths on a Skilling Path

The Skills to Livelihood programme run by Development Alternatives, with support from HDB Financial Services, provides training in various skills for a sustainable and dignified livelihood and income-generating opportunities to school drop-outs and unemployed women & youth in Rajasthan. Within a span of 12 months, a total of 1200 trainees in Jaipur (Rajasthan) will be reached out through the skill development programme. A mix of conventional courses and innovative solution driven courses has been rolled out. On 16th May 2019, a graduation ceremony was organised to felicitate the trained candidates with certificates. The programme was organised at the Vocational Training centre, Shastri Nagar & Pratap Nagar Jaipur. About 132 women and 72 youth attended the programme. Maj. Gen.
