How did we achieve it?

TARA Akshar+ (adult literacy programme) is a passport to a fullfilling life for women in India

With innovative ICT based technology, this adult literacy programme imparts functional literacy in Hindi and basic arithmetic in just 56 days through a comprehensive software. This is followed by a six month post-literacy programme called Gyan Chaupali, which not only strengthens the literacy base of women but also imparts information on topics of finance, entrepreneurship, rights and entitlements, health, and livelihood preparedness to bring in the 'application' part of literacy into the lives of women.

Through functional literacy, women in India have a real opportunity to transform their lives and enrich the lives of people around them. The programme has enabled 230,000 women in India in the last decade, making them aware citizens, contributing to society as a strong 'social capital' and leading to overall community development.
