

Placement Drive for Skills to Livelihood Program Participants

The Prabhat 'Skills to Livelihood' program is a significant step towards providing dignified and sustainable livelihoods for unemployed youth from underprivileged and economically disadvantaged backgrounds.

On September 5, 2023, the Prabhat team organised a 'Placement Drive' at the Prabhat Livelihood Center in Sonipat. This event was a concerted effort to create an employment platform for young graduates who had successfully completed their training at the Prabhat center, as well as for other capable youth from within the community. The primary objective of the placement drive was to present diverse employment opportunities to the youth, encouraging them to step forward, showcase their potential, and secure a path to financial independence.



Our team collaborated with employers (Quess Corp, Dahiya placement agency, SBI, HDBFS) from four different companies to facilitate the participation of nearly 50 students in the fair. Interviews were arranged (on-site and online) and among the participants, 39 were graduates of the Prabhat center, while 11 were participants from community. The event commenced with an orientation session for the students, during which each employer introduced themselves, elucidating the available job designations, roles, responsibilities, as well as salary and benefits. Subsequently, the students were given the

freedom to approach any employer with their resumes.

During the first half of the day, employers from Quess Corp, Dahiya Placement Agency, and HDBFS conducted interviews, and in the second half, SBI conducted online interviews.

The job fair marked the completion of the initial round of interviews for the employers. A total of 29 students out of the 50 were shortlisted in the first round and will be invited for a second round of interviews. For many of these students, it was their maiden experience with job interviews. However, the employers generously shared feedback regarding the students' performance and offered valuable insights into interview techniques. This feedback will assist the Prabhat team in identifying areas for improvement among the students.

The efforts of the Prabhat team were highly commended by both the students and the employers for organising a successful event. The dedication exhibited by the team and the enthusiasm displayed by the students are bound to serve as a source of inspiration for many more young individuals within the community.
